Obviously, the 2018 Expenses-to-Revenue ratio cannot be maintained if SWT hopes to stay afloat.

As can be seen, the costs for contractors, materials, equipment rentals/purchases, and tools and supplies were abnormally high in 2018 due to various non-recurring tasks (such as work on the *Riverwalk* or the *TRAFx* purchase). A return to normal cost levels may provide some relief in the coming years (although it seems reasonable to expect that currently un-planned projects could also spring up in the future).

Some recurring expenses are likely to be covered in part by grants (such as students hired through the CYE program and general trail maintenance) and will likely not end up being too costly for SWT in the medium-to-long run.

However, I strongly urge the Board of Directors to explore crowd-sourcing and other fundraising avenues in order to decrease SWT's reliance on grant monies.

NOTE: Online donations made through the TCT website, for an unofficial total of **\$3460.00** (\$910.00 reserved for the Bench project), are not included in this report as the funds have not yet been transferred to SWT.
